* a full stop .



* a question mark?



* a comma ,



* speech marks " "



* an exclamation mark!

It is very important that your child reads their Home Reader every day. Please ask your child to use their 'Windows' to find an upper case letter, a lower case letter, a word, a full stop, a question mark, a comma, speech marks and an exclamation mark. Maybe they can find these punctuation marks in other books at home as well.

It is also very important that your child learns all letter names and sounds. The children use their knowledge of letter names and sounds to attempt to write words and read words.
